The offence of manipulations of sports competitions is a serious issue. The purpose of this course is to help you understanding this phenomenon: how badly it can affect volleyball and your life, how important to step up against it collectively and understanding the consequences of committing sport manipulation.

You will be introduced to integrity- related topics in the spirit of the FIVB's mission to keep volleyball clean: you will meet topics such as sport manipulation, betting, reporting, inside information and disciplinary procedures, as well as sanctions from the FIVB Disciplinary Regulations.

The course will take around 35-40 minutes and has videos, interesting information, simple test questions and a Volleyball legend. In order to accomplish the course, you need to use speakers or earphones.




